Policies/Guidelines: - A recommendation to the incoming committee that the Association need to send out

formulated.

We also need to look at the Walking Access Commission to see what policies they

have.

Poaching: -

The association needs to state their role in how this will be dealt with. The Association are not the police and we represent all pig hunters, poaching should be dealt with between the related clubs.

Meeting Locations: -

Consideration is given to have a meeting in the South Island - All Agreed

Advertising: -

Grant Bunting asked if there was an opportunity for advertising funding for the South Island, his approximate was \$200.00 excluding GST. — All agreed that this is possible, and would be discussed at the first committee meeting.

South Island Tour: -

This was very well received by the South Island Pig Hunters; the new committee should look at having more tours again later in the year.

GPS tracking: -

This will be continued to be worked on by the new committee and will be addressed at the first committee meeting.

Incident: -

Trevor Allan and James Corban addressed the attendees on an incident that happened with a Pig Hunter and DOC meeting, details are to be given to Garry Ottmann by Trevor Allan and details will go into the newsletter. The New Zealand Pig Hunting Association Inc does not associate with violence.

Sponsorship: -

Swazi has approached the New Zealand Pig Hunting Association Inc and offered to be our major sponsor; Geoffrey FitzGerald is working on this opportunity which includes a ranger of clothing. It was asked if Swazi could look at a Hi Viz Short Sleeve Vest. There is a possibility that the Association will get 10% of all sales from this package. Caps: -

The committee has been requested to look into the making of Caps; this is to be looked at by the new committee as it is very cheap advertising.

Sika Show: -

Recommendation to the incoming committee to look into having a stall at the Sika Show in Taupo. Garry Ottmann to look into this for the committee.

Meeting Venues: -

The meeting attendees have approved that a large proportion of meetings be held in Hamilton, as this is more central to the new committee members. We will also look at having the odd meeting to be held in another location.
